• SCIENCE OF RECOVERY: FLASH/POSTER SESSION GUIDELINES

- Tues August 22nd 4:45p -6:15p | Congress Ballroom DE
- Five (5) national scholars/research teams from around the country have been invited to share the main framework of their recovery related research
 - University of Maryland, School of Social Work
 - Public Science Collaborative
 - Iowa State University
 - Yale University
 - · University of Iowa
- Each group with be given a total of five (5) minutes on-stage to deliver a brief synapsis of their research and key findings
- Once all five teams have presented on-stage, their posters will be put on display to discuss their findings in depth with the audience for the remainder of the session
 - Posters will remain in the concourse area for the remainder of the conference for additional exposure

FLASH SESSION PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

- Presentation order will be assigned and determined during check-in
- All presenting team members must arrive to Congress DE no later than 4:25pm on Tuesday August 22nd
- Each group must stay within the timed five (5) minute stage presentation limit and include the following required information:
 - Title of the project, including names and affiliations of everyone involved
 - The research question(s)
 - The significance/rationale for your work
 - A brief overview of data/methods
 - Key findings/conclusions
- Slide decks are optional- but encouraged, and limited to a total of five (5) slides containing the required information listed above

POSTER GUIDELINES:

- Teams are responsible for the creation of their poster and given creative liberty to present their findings
- Posters should be no larger than 24"x36" in size, positioned in either portrait or landscape orientation
- · While on display, the poster will need to balance and be free standing on an easel provided by the venue
- Posters must be submitted and dropped off at the CCAR Registration table no later than 1:45p on Tues Aug 22nd
